_____ Pass a comprehensive examination from the content of the course prior to the one to which the student is requesting readmission with a minimum grade of 80 and demonstrate competency of skills required in nursing courses prior to the one to which the student is requesting readmission.

_____ Students may retake the course prior to the one to which they are requesting readmission for a higher grade. However, enrollment in this course does not guarantee readmission to the program. For readmission, students must earn a grade of "B" or higher in the course or an 80 on the final exam, and demonstrate competency of skills required for the course. Also, admission to this class is based on space availability.

_____ Students may request to audit the nursing course in the sequence prior to the one to which they are requesting readmission. However, enrollment for auditing this class does not guarantee readmission to the program. For readmission students must earn a grade of "B" or higher in the course and satisfactory demonstration of nursing skills. Also, admission to this class is based on space availability.

Auditing – The student who audits any course related to the nursing curriculum while seeking readmission will register and pay for the course, complete a request to audit, and attend class on the basis of the regularly enrolled student who is seeking credit for the course. Further, they are expected to participate in tests, classroom activities, labs, and examinations relating to the course and satisfactorily complete the course with a "B" or better to progress to the next course. The letter grade will be recorded in the roll book within the department. The official school report card will record an "AU". Pell grant monies may not be used to pay expenses for courses being audited. Students who are dismissed for clinical safety issues or behavior problems unresponsive to treatment will not be considered for readmission.

1. Students who are terminated from a nursing course (academic failure, voluntary withdrawal or instructor drop) may apply for readmission. However, readmission is **not guaranteed**.
2. A student may have two admissions into the ADN program, the PNE program or Advanced Placement. Once enrolled in a PNE program, the student must successfully complete the program and obtain PN licensure before enrolling in the ADN program.
3. If the student has been out of the program for more than one year or was unsuccessful in their first nursing course, the student will be required to reapply to the program and follow the admission process as outlined (See SCC College Catalog – Admission to Nursing Programs).
4. If a student has been unsuccessful at another college more than one time or has an unsatisfactory clinical grade, he or she will not be admitted into the same program.
