Thank you for your inquiry about the Basic Law Enforcement Training Academy. I am enclosing a BLET application packet. Please begin on your paperwork as soon as possible. I would like to have all applications turned in at least one week prior to scheduled registration.

Prior to enrolling in the Basic Law Enforcement Training Academy at Sampson Community College, applicants will need to set up an appointment and meet with the School Director. BLET candidates must satisfactorily complete a Reading Comprehension Test and have at least a 10th grade reading level. Please bring your completed packet for the interview. At that time we will discuss any issues pertaining to the packet and answer any questions you may have.

Your returned packet should contain the following, and any additional material enclosed with your packet:

1. Certified court records from each county in every state that you have lived as an adult from age 16 to the present
2. Official high school transcript or GED completion
3. Completed medical forms F-1 and F-2
4. A certified copy of your driving record from DMV
5. Applicants need a sponsorship letter from a city or county law enforcement agency. *No student will be admitted to the program without a sponsorship letter.*
6. A completed Personal History Statement F-3
7. Proof of citizenship is required (i.e. birth certificate)
8. A copy of your driver's license and social security card

Each student will be required to have the following text materials prior to the start of the course:

Laws of Arrest, Search, and Investigation in North Carolina PLUS supplement
NC Crimes: A Guidebook on the Elements of Crime PLUS supplement
Motor Vehicle Laws of North Carolina
North America Emergency Response Handbook
Judicial System of NC Guidebook

Before physical training begins, students should purchase the following:

1. Two pairs of plain light gray sweat pants and shirts. No markings or logos are allowed on any clothing
2. One pair of gray shorts (light or dark)
3. Two gray T-Shirts
4. At least three pairs of khaki dress pants. No cargo pants.
5. A pair of hard soled shoes-black in color. No boots will be allowed. Heels can be no more than one inch. Shoes must be smooth tops.
6. A plain black belt must be worn with the pants.

When BLET begins we will place orders for class shirts. Until that time, please wear a dress shirt with your khaki pants. The BLET class will meet in O-211.
