

Distance Learning Changes ~ Summer Semester 2010 ~

Web and hybrid courses for Summer Semester 2010, will be available for students to access on May 19, 2010, by 5:00 p.m.

What do I need to do to begin my web or hybrid course?

Students taking a web or hybrid course will be required to complete a Blackboard proficiency assignment during the first week of the semester. This will replace the previous online proficiency requirement. Instructions for the mandatory assignment can be located in your web or hybrid Blackboard course. Students can complete the assignment once the course is available, and send a copy to the instructor for each web or hybrid course. Students will be dropped from any web or hybrid course if the instructor does not receive the mandatory assignment by the 10% point of the summer semester which is May 25, 2010.



What if I need or want face-to-face Blackboard training?

There will be two optional face-to-face Blackboard training sessions that students can attend in addition to completing the required assignment. This session is highly recommended for any student who is taking a web or hybrid course for the first time here at Sampson Community College. The sessions will be held in the Technology Building, Room 207, on a first-come first-served basis. The following dates and times are scheduled below:
