

What do I need to do if I am interested in SGA?

HOW CAN I JOIN SGA?

All curriculum students who pay an activity fee are already members of SGA.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT AS A MEMBER OF SGA?

Each semester, the SGA provides activities like the Fall Festival, the Spring Festival, the Ms. SCC Pageant, Santa Land, and other exciting activities and events on campus. SGA members assist with the planning of these activities and events and participate in these activities and events. SGA holds meetings during each month to discuss school events and issues.

HOW CAN I BE AN SGA OFFICER?

Elections for the SGA Vice-President and Secretary are held during the third week of the fall semester. If you are interested in running for one of these offices, come by Student Services the first week of the fall semester to pick up a petition to campaign. Presidential elections are held during the spring semester. For more detailed information on elections, consult your current Sampson Community College Student Handbook.

HOW CAN I BE A REPRESENTATIVE ON THE SGA SENATE?

During the second week of the fall semester, each curriculum will hold a meeting to elect one representative and one alternate. If you are interested in serving, tell your department chairperson. Representatives and alternates must maintain a 2.0 GPA and attend all SGA meetings.

CAN I GIVE IDEAS FOR CAMPUS ACTIVITIES?

Yes. If you are a representative, let your ideas be known at senate meetings. If you are an activity-fee paying member and not a member of the senate, tell your ideas to your SGA representative and he/she will present them at the next SGA meeting.

WHO PAYS FOR CAMPUS ACTIVITIES?

Each semester, students pay an activity fee. The SGA Senate adopts an annual budget to determine expenditures. This activity fee funds activities and events for students on the SCC campus.

DOES SGA PROVIDE A STUDENT PUBLICATION?

Yes. *The Viking Voice*, a monthly student newsletter, is composed by the Student Activities Coordinator. This newsletter includes news of general student interest and informs students of campus events and special activities.

WHERE SHOULD I LOOK FOR INFORMATION ON SGA ACTIVITIES?

In *The Viking Voice*, on the bulletin board in the Student Center game room, on the message display board located in the Student Center lounge, and on SC2HOLAR.
